Many people outside Russia know the song by Alla Pugacheva about the million of roses. In Russia itself, there are probably no people who don't know it! But very few people know that this great hit was in fact a cover. Pugacheva herself knew it. And she has always disliked her song, though it was one of the most popular among tens of millions of people. Pugacheva knew that the song was originally not of her own and wanted to sing only those songs that had been written specially for her. Well, the song about roses was originally a charming song popular only in Latvia - part of the Soviet Russia at that time (end of the 60s - beginning of the 79s). And the female performer who originally sang it was Larisa Mondrusa, a Latvian Jew, who is now known just as Larisa and acts as a German singer.
